

Facility Guidelines for Players 10 & Under

With COVID there are new protocols to follow when bringing your player to the rink to participate in hockey. Below outlines guidelines and restrictions for parents and guardians of children 10 years of age and under. Please read all information carefully as SLMHA must adhere to the regulations set up by the OMHA and the City of Kawartha Lakes.

Drop Off

Players are to arrive dressed in their hockey gear.

- Please have your player use the washroom before they put on the gear.
- Skates on with guards (please have name on skate guards)
Or Skates, helmet, and gloves in a small bag.
We have an area that the coaches can help players put on skates.

Parents are to fill out the COVID pre-screening report for the player.

- Reports are to be filled out electronically on the website, using the QR code and your mobile device.
- Reports are to be completed before the start of your scheduled ice time, a maximum of 2 hours before the ice time.
- Anyone that does not have a completed report will not have access to the facility.

Entry to the facility will happen 10min before the scheduled ice time at the main entrance.

- Players having completed the pre-screen will be brought in as a group by the COVID representative.

The number of people in the facility is limited by the City of Kawartha Lakes therefore, we are asking parents not to enter unless absolutely necessary.

- Players under the age of 10 are permitted to have one parent /guardian go in with them, but they must exit, immediately when player is dressed.

Entry to the facility requires the following:

- Any person entering the facility must be properly wearing a mask.
- Any person entering the facility must complete the COVID pre-screen form.
- Any person entering the facility must be on the attendance list.
- Players entering the facility must be wearing a mask. (Mask is removed and placed in bag when on ice)

Pick Up

Players will exit the ice at the direction of the coaching staff through the designated door on the ice surface.

Players will collect their small bag, outdoor wear and mask.

Players will be leaving in full gear, or with only skates and helmet removed.

Masks are required to be on when leaving the facility.

Players will be leaving through the rear door, so we have one-way traffic in the facility.

- Parents / guardians that are helping get players off and ready to go will be granted access to the facility through the main doors at the end of the ice time.
- The doors are opened 10 minutes before the next ice time.
- This must be the same parent / guardian that assisted the player onto the ice. (The person on the attendance list)

Players must be checked out, so they do not count for numbers for the next group.

Parent / guardian must also be checked out on the attendance list.
