Manager of The Year Award: This award is presented to a SLMHA Team Manager who has shown dedication to their team through countless hours of volunteer work. This person represents a positive public image for Sturgeon Lake Minor Hockey. The Executive will review nominations with supporting information and vote on a winner. COACHES, TRAINERS & MANAGERS are needed FOR 2018-19 SEASON

Interested in helping with your son/daughter's hockey team?

- 1. If you or anyone you may know is interested in coaching Three County at any level or assisting with any OMHA or TC team in an assistant coach, trainer or manager role, please contact the Supervisor of Coaches, Managers and Trainers, Brian Taylor, at briantaylorslt@gmail.com.
- 2. Interviews for OMHA Head Coaches will occur in late February/March. If you are interested in being a Head Coach for Three County, you will be contacted for an interview, only if there are additional applicants.
- 3. Once approved by the SLMHA executive, you will need to set up an Ehockey account through the Hockey Canada registry. (only if you don't already have one **do not** create a second one) For more information click the following link. Setting up Ehockey.
- 4. All volunteers must complete the Gender Identity and Expression online course (link here) through the OMHA. Scroll down and click on the Gender Identity and Expression Course. You need only complete it once and then it will be added to your Ehockey account.
- 5. All volunteers must complete the Respect in Sport-Activity Leader (<u>link here</u>) online module through the OMHA. You need only complete it once and it should be in your Ehockey account. Respect in Sport -Activity Leader.
- 6. All volunteers must complete a Vulnerable Sector Record Check through their local police provider. If you are in City of Kawartha Lakes, it is the OPP in Lindsay. If you are in Trent Lakes, it is the OPP in Peterborough. If you live in Lindsay or Ops Township it is the municipal police service in Lindsay. The President will provide you with a volunteer letter to take with you so there is no charge.
- 7. Coaches: Register for the appropriate coaching clinic through the OMHA website. Click on the link. (<u>Coach Education Coaching Clinics</u>) Then click on Coaching Clinic listings and scroll down to find one that satisfies the necessary requirements. (<u>2018-19 OMHA Coaching Staff Requirements</u>)
- 8. Trainers: Complete the online trainer's course through the OMHA. (follow instructions for online level 1 trainer's course)
- 9. Once you have completed the online Respect in Sport-Activity Leader course and the appropriate coaching/trainer's course, forward your receipts to the SLMHA Treasurer (treasurer@sturgeonthunderhockey.ca). SLMHA will reimburse 50% of your costs the first year you are rostered to a SLMHA team and the remaining 50% when you are rostered for a second season with a SLMHA team.



OMHA TRY-OUTS 2018-19

OMHA try-outs will occur during the spring, depending on ice availability. Announcement will follow soon, so please check the SLMHA web-site for up-dates. All players trying out for an OMHA team must be registered and ALL registration fees paid in full. There will be a try-out fee of \$30 per player, due prior to the first try-out. Following the second try-out, selected players will be invited to the third and subsequent try-outs. Any player unavailable to attend either of the first two try-outs must contact the appropriate OMHA coach (Head Coaches will be posted on SLMH website when selected by the Executive) and e-mail Brian Taylor @ briantaylorslt@gmail.com.

In an effort to better communicate the levels of hockey, SLMHA are offering for the 2018 / 2019 season, please read below.

Intro to Hockey / Pre-School (3,4,5 years old)

<u>Never played hockey</u> - Introduce your son or daughter to Canada's favorite game, in a fun, supportive environment. The Intro to Hockey program is designed to teach fundamental hockey skills to your son or daughter, in-order to ensure they are ready for their first year of hockey. Each player will receive instruction that will increase their confidence on the ice and familiarize them with all aspects of the game. Our lesson plans are designed to be FUN for all participants.

We believe that perfection and excellence come through repetition and as such all sessions will follow the same basic program, outline and structure with new drills and other small variations.

Amount of ice time per week – 1 hour / every Saturday.

No games - skills are the focus.

Registration Payment Due - August 1st deadline.

Season Starts in October / Ends March

Initiation (5 & 6 years old)

The main goal is to make the beginner's first impression of hockey a good one! When players get started on a positive note, they automatically enjoy the game and usually go on to have fun playing hockey for many years. Hockey Canada developed the Initiation Program to make the first contact with hockey a safe and positive experience. It is a structured, learn-to-play hockey program designed to introduce beginners to the game's basic skills. It enables participants to become contributing members of a team, develop self-confidence, and experience a sense of personal achievement. These goals are achieved in an atmosphere of fun and fair play.

Amount of ice time per week: 2 - 1-hour time slots + away games once they start.

Games - Skills + Cross Ice Games. (Games to start mid to late December)

Registration Payment Due – August 1st deadline.

Season - Starts in October / Ends March

Tyke Hockey (7 years old)

Starting in the 2017-2018 season, the Tyke program underwent structural changes in an effort to better develop our players, provide a program that better suits the needs of our players and most of all, make the experience more positive and enjoyable for all our Tyke players. The intent is to provide a better experience to our players while they learn the basic skills and grow a fundamental foundation for years to come.

Amount of ice time per week: 2 / 1-hour time slots + 1,2 away game dates pending schedule.
